VIOLET & VICTOR CLARK HOUSE FIRE 623 School Street Carrollton, Illinois NOVEMBER 1950

In November 1950 power went out on School Street and as the weather was cold Victor Clark started a fire in a newly constructed fireplace located along the east wall of the living room. Victor and Violet had remodeled and had the fire place installed in the home.

Unknown to Victor a brick was left out of the burn chamber or brick chimney when constructed. When the fire was started in the fire place, fire quickly burned through the plaster or mortared spot in the fire place and spread up the inside wall between the living room and a guest bedroom east of the living room.

Fire extended up the wall and burned through the attic subfloor and burned out the center section of the roof. The Carrollton Fire Department responded to the fire. Fire did extensive damage to the attic and roof of the Clark residence.

The following photographs show the damage and the beginning of the home repair.






